Re: Mosaiq[™] 21 CFR Part 11 Compliance at Northern NSW & Mid North Coast Local Health Districts

In order to comply with the US FDA Section 21 of the United States Code of Federal Regulations, Part 11 the following documents are supplied:

- Completed and Signed 21 CFR 11 Worksheet Assessments (Appendix 1)
 - Some examples of the compliance worksheet includes:
 - Regular back-up of data;
 - o Storage of back-up media in a secure location;
 - A contingency plan exists in case MosaiqTM is unavailable;
 - A full audit trail can be established, allowing the tracking of entries/deletions into/from MosaiqTM by date, time, identity of person making entry/deletion, reason for entry/deletion and other standard parameters;
 - A reasonable level of security, including specifically that Mosaiq[™] access is restricted, that all users have a unique user identification and password, and that the use of Mosaiq[™] can be monitored through a full audit trail; and
 - Appropriate training is given to MosaiqTM users on a documented basis.
- Declaration by the Manager of the Cancer Clinical Trials Unit for the procedure of external parties access to the Oncology eMR (MosaiqTM) system for the purposes of source data verification (Appendix 2)
